Members are spread across the state, some in rural and remote areas, without an easy way to connect with each other. As an organization, AMA Queensland wanted to find a better way for its members to connect & engage with the association and each other.

RESULT

Now, AMA Queensland has a central hub for members, a platform where their privacy is protected: the Queensland Doctors' Community (QDC). Members can engage with one another, the association, and AMA Queensland's partners and sponsors whenever they want to. Thanks to these community conversations, AMA Queensland now has insight into trends and the issues their entire member base is facing, so their members' needs can truly drive their work.
